THE FLAG & GENERAL OFFICERS' NETWORK

PURPOSE

- To provide information, logistics, and systemic details regarding Flag & General Officer networking and job opportunities and a broad range of programs and projects focused on Flag/General Officers, managed and administered by fellow Flag & General Officers.

DISCUSSION

- The Flag & General Officers' Network (TFGON) currently has over 3800 active duty, reserve, guard and retired admirals and generals as members of their network----that's almost 90% of all living U. S. Military flag and general officers. The network is 24 years old, charges no dues, and funds all their activities and events through the attendees at their networking events and voluntary semi-annual donations. - Founded in 1994 by Flag & General Officers, Operated and Administered by Flag & General Officers, and funded by Flag & General Officers **FOR** Flag & General Officers
- Only requirement for membership and participation is to have been promoted to O-7 in one of the five United States Armed Services. To apply for membership, send an e-mail indicating name, rank, branch of service, period of service, preferred e-mail address, and a sentence requesting membership to TFGONAdmin@TFGON.org

- Meets quarterly at a regularly scheduled networking reception event in the Washington, DC area. Annual schedule posted on the website [click on Calendar on the left hand side of the home page] so those from out of town can plan business or other travel accordingly and participate. Regional networking receptions being planned in other locations.
- TFGON circulates member resumes via e-mail of any Flag or General Officer in the network to their entire membership and to selected executive search firms that have job opportunities fitting Flag & General Officers. This service is free of charge and has proven particularly effective for those Flag & General Officers retiring from their uniformed service and those already retired who are seeking to change jobs or find new opportunities in Career # 2 or # 3. TFGON oversees and administers the Transportation Security Administration [TSA] airport security program, TSA PreCheck, for retired flag and general officers by appointment from TSA. To apply, you need to be retired from active duty or active guard or reserve service, and a member of TFGON [which provides initial screening] and then send an e-mail to TFGONAdmin@TFGON.org with TSA PreCheck in the subject line and providing us with your full name, military rank and branch of service, date of birth, and the ID Card Number from the face of your DOD Retired ID Card. This ID Card Number will also become your TSA PreCheck Known Traveler Number once submitted to and approved by TSA.
